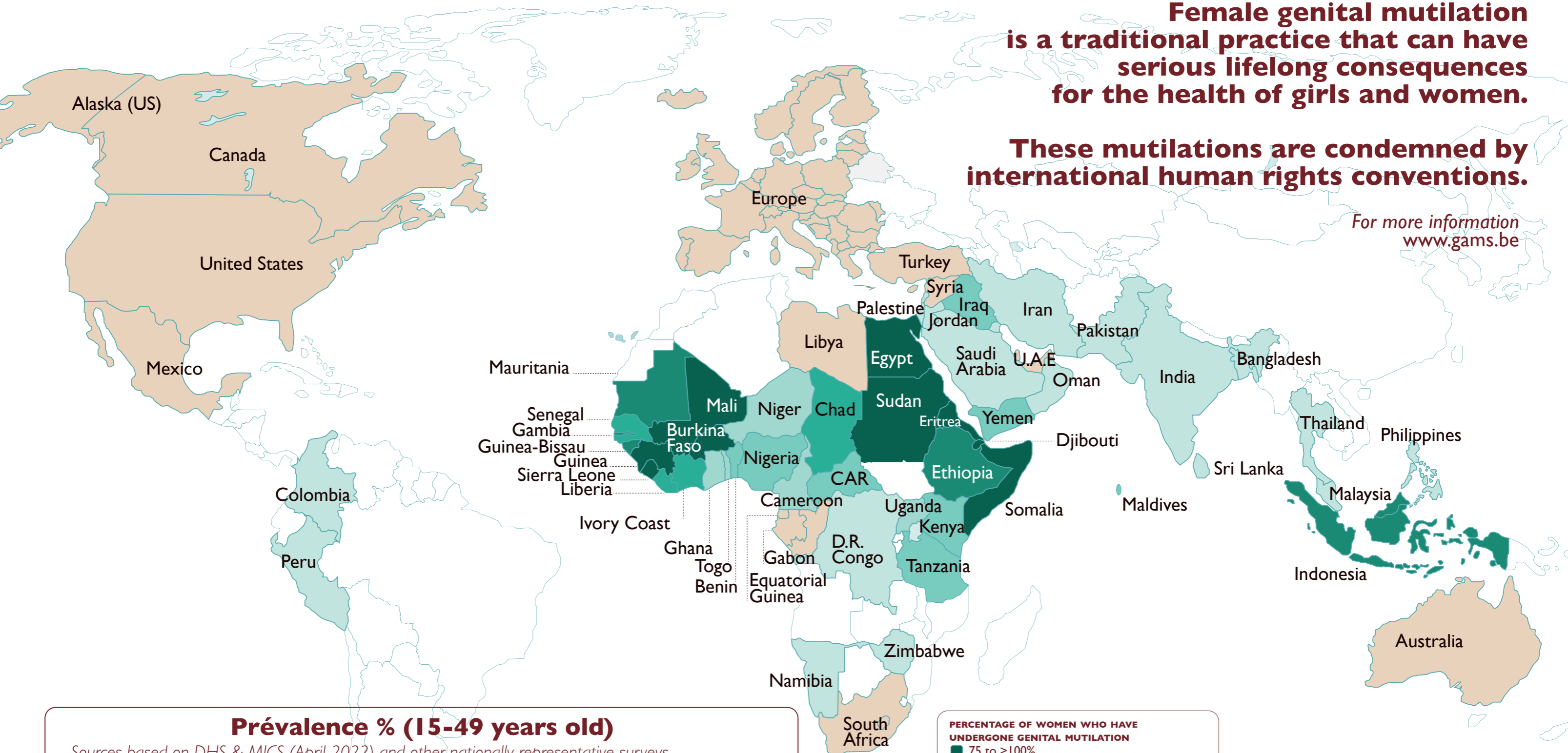


PREVALENCE OF FEMALE GENITAL MUTILATION IN THE WORLD
